

**Call meeting to order:** Meeting called to order at 5:31pm

### Discussion and Possible Action

1. **Approval of April 2025 Agenda**
  - i. Motion to approve by Thompson, seconded by Folk. Motion carries.
2. **Approval of January 2025 Meeting Minutes**
  - i. Motion to approve by Elder, seconded by Phillips. Motion carries.
3. **Approval of January 2025 Bills**
  - i. Braudis reviewed January bills, Mansager asked what a "CDE" was and Braudis advised it's hours of continuing education. Motion to approve by Folk, seconded by Abrahams. Roll call taken. All ayes. Motion carries.
4. **Approval of February 2025 Bills**
  - i. Braudis reviewed the February bills. No questions or concerns. Motion to approve by Welton, seconded by Thoms. Roll call taken. All ayes. Motion carries.
5. **Approval of March 2025 Bills**
  - i. Braudis reviewed the March bills. No questions or concerns. Motion to approve by Thompson, seconded by Folk. Roll call taken. All ayes. Motion carries.
6. **UPH / Shomo-Madsen Training Contributions**
  - i. Braudis reviewed training funds that contributed by UPH and Shomo-Madsen. UPH contributed \$2,500 and Shomo-Madsen contributed \$300. No questions or concerns.
7. **Leadership Workshop / Free Training Received**
  - i. Was discussed during March 2025 bills. No additional questions or concerns.
8. **HSB 104 – Surcharge / SF 271 / HF951**
  - i. Braudis explained that HSB 104 is now dead in its current state. There could be changes in the future and she will keep the board updated. She then explained the purpose of SF 271 and that it is also dead in its current state. Folk asked about how the board would be set up in terms of if the communications center were to consolidate. Braudis advised that they would not be a part of the board, but it would be set up with other agencies more as agreements. Braudis then discussed HF951 and its purpose. She is unsure how far it will go or if it will be also be dead in its current state, but will continue to update the board. Folk asked of clarification about legislature appropriating funds for a specific agency for disaster recovery. No other questions or concerns.
9. **Position 6 Radio – Information**
  - i. Braudis explained that there is a position/console that needs radio equipment (it is currently a call-taker only station). There was an increase in approx. \$20,000 from the last quote. Welton asked what was included in the quote (equipment/labor).
